

### Welcome back to Unicorn Class

### History:

This term, we will continue exploring the history of flight and how aviation has evolved over time. We will compare early flying machines with modern aircraft and study key historical figures, including Amelia Earhart. Additionally, we will examine the legacy of the Wright Brothers and the impact of flight and international travel on the world.

### Science

During term 4, we will be continuing to learn all about animals, including humans. We will begin by learning why exercise is important. We will then understand how to maintain a balanced diet and look into the difference between healthy and unhealthy food types. This term is also national Science week and we will be engaging in lots of exciting activities!

### English

This term our learning will be based on the story 'Major Glad, Major Dizzy' by Jan Oke. Our writing outcome is to write a recount of historical events from the text from Major Glad's point of view. Along the way we will be developing our range of vocabulary, joining words and clauses using 'and' & write in the past tense.

### Maths

Year 2: This term, we will begin our multiplication and division unit by exploring the 2, 5, and 10 times tables. Our focus will also be on sharing and grouping, leading to division by 2, 5, and 10. We will end the term by studying statistics, including making tally charts and pictograms.

Year 1: This term, we will explore numbers up to 50, including grouping in tens and partitioning into tens and ones. We will then introduce length and height, using rulers to measure. Finally, we will end the term by exploring weight.

### PE

Unicorn class will have two PE sessions a week: on Tuesday and Thursday. Please continue to send your children in to school wearing their PE kits. We will be learning ball skills, running skills such as pace and developing our balancing skills.

### Phonics

Children will continue to practise daily phonics to help them decode and blend sounds to form words. Please continue to read every night to support their progression.

### RE

This term we will be looking at 'What do Christians believe God is like?'

### Computing

This term we will be creating animated story books. We will be adding animations, sounds and pictures to our e-books. E-safety is also covered every term.

### P.S.H.E

This term our focus is 'Healthy Me'. We will learn how important exercise is and why it is important to stay healthy. We will also learn about medicine and road safety.

### DT

This term the children will be making our sock puppets. Last term we designed them and we can't wait to use them in a puppet show.

### Music

This term we will be practising our singing and performance skills and learning simple notes on the glockenspiel.
